house after my father passed away.

We also had a secret code we would use to gain entrance into the club house. It was Morse code for the letter "W" in wizard – a short buzz followed by two long buzzes on the clubhouse doorbell.

Yes, I had installed a doorbell buzzer plus lights for our grand clubhouse. We soon expanded our membership to nclude our sisters; Debbie Hubbard, Brenda & Pam Vare, my cousin, Joleen Hatch, and Debbie's good riend, Brenda Marben. We ad monthly dues of 5 cents nd I kept attendance for our veekly meetings.

The attendance record vhich I still have, shows hat interest in our secret lub declined rapidly once ummer arrived, until only immy and I were attending nost of the meetings. That vas also probably due to the act that if you weren't science erds like Jimmy and I, the neetings quickly got pretty oring.

I remember that Jimmy ot a big chemistry set for Christmas and during our lub meetings, we would ust randomly mix chemicals ogether to see what appened. And if nothing happened, we'd heat the mixture up with an alcohol burner to see if that would cause a reaction.

I do remember cooking up some pretty rotten smelling potions - probably precursors to Love Potion Number 9. We also played around with liquid mercury that we salvaged from light switches and other devices. We'd roll it around in our hands and rub it on silver dimes, quarters and half dollar coins to make them shiny.

If my column appears to ramble aimlessly at times, just chalk it up to mercury poisoning 60 years ago.

We also wired up all sorts of different electronic circuits with my HeathKit Electronic Workshop science kit at club meetings. We made an AM radio station that could broadcast throughout our neighborhood, an intercom system that went from my bedroom to our clubhouse, an AM radio receiver that could receive WCCO and the Twins games, and many other electronic projects. We also figured out how to make an electrical generator out of some old washing machine motors. There were many blown circuit breakers at my house, but we somehow managed not to electrocute ourselves or burn my house down. Now you know all the secrets behind Tracy's CER club. I eventually continued my interest in electricity and radios by getting a degree in Electrical Engineering. My good friend, Jim Ware, and his family moved out of Tracy in the fall after the club was founded. He eventually settled on the east coast after college and became a newspaper reporter. We now are both retired and still stay in touch to this day.
