Xcel Energy is hosting open houses for landowners to learn more about current route options under consideration for the MN Energy Connection project.

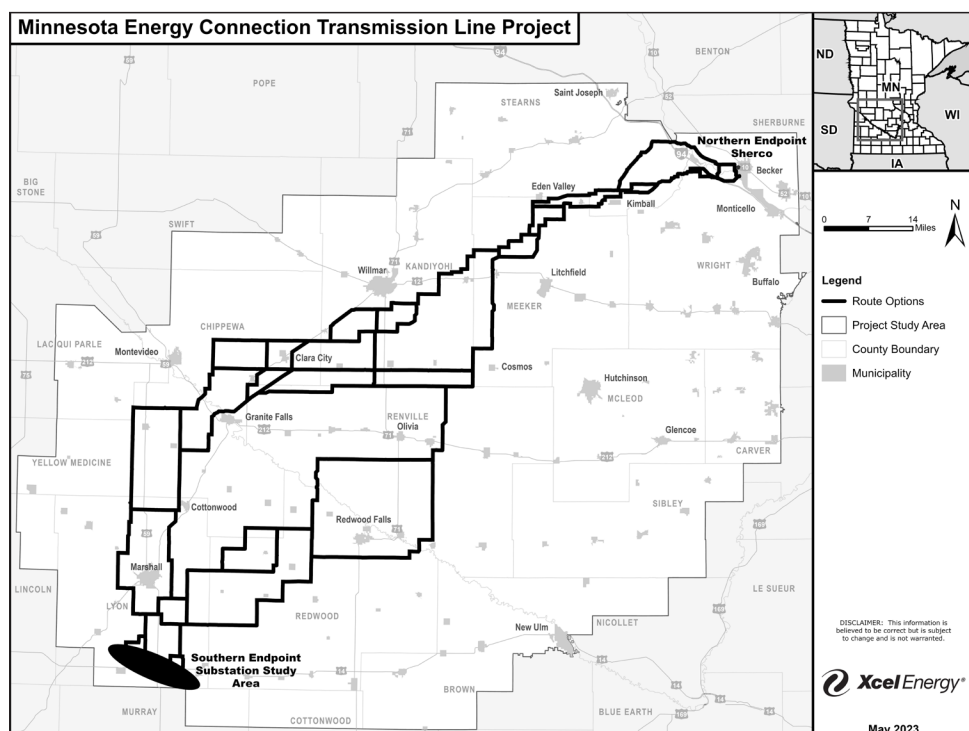
