

Sports Flashbacks

Excerpts from past Tracy newspapers

Feb. 4, 1954 — Tracy's courageous Scrapppers staved off a determined Slayton rally Tuesday night in the auditorium and rapped the Wildcats 60-53 with a final minute spurt that put the game on ice. Ronald Cyr scored 23 points for Tracy, and Jim Dilly chipped in with 11.

Jan. 30, 1964 — A hot-shooting Tracy High School basketball team rolled over Springfield 80-58 in the armory-municipal arena Friday night. Gary Sandbo's 13 fielders and five charity tosses for 31 points paced the Scrapppers.

Jan. 31, 1974 — Jeff Farber

scored 18 points but it wasn't enough for the Loggers, who lost to Storden-Jeffers 60-52. Tim Bertschi added 15 and Tim Wester 11.

Feb. 2, 1984 — Darren Willard, Tracy's 98-pound entry, set the pace in his opening bout Tuesday night against Pipestone by winning a 20-8 superior decision while the Scrapppers defeated the Arrows 36-18. Also winning were Tom Byrne, Paul DeVetter, Karl Campbell, Jim Coyle, Wade Landa, Doug LeClaire and Todd Maeyaert.

Feb. 2, 1994 — The Tracy-Milroy Panthers moved to 10-3 as they overpowered Balaton 75-21 at Tracy. Kathy Ankrum and Mandy Coquyt both scored 17 points.

Feb. 4, 2004 — The Panther wrestling team upset highly-ranked Jackson County Central, a team receiving votes for class 2A Top 12, 42-37 at Tracy. TMB got seven pins — from Derek Evans, Cole Cooreman, Chad Cooreman, James Prairie, Dan Deiter, Andy Nelson and Paul Carlson.

Jan. 29, 2014 — A tenacious, pressing Panther defense wore down Lac qui Parle and broke open what had been a close game in the first half. Cassie Hook (13) and Kaylee Kirk (10) led TMB in scoring.
